

RESOLUTION NO. 111821-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF BEAVER, ACCEPTING AND APPROVING THE BEAVER COUNTY 2021 HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN, WHICH IDENTIFIES HAZARDS, INSTITUTES COMMUNITY GOALS AND SELECTS MITIGATION OPPORTUNITIES APPROPRIATE FOR BEAVER COUNTY;

WHEREAS, the municipalities of Beaver County, Pennsylvania are most vulnerable to natural and human-made hazards which may result in loss of life and property, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000) requires state and local governments to develop and submit for approval to the President a mitigation plan that outlines processes for identifying their respective natural hazards, risks, and vulnerabilities; and

WHEREAS, Beaver County acknowledges the requirements of Section 322 of DMA 2000 to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a prerequisite to receiving post-disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds; and

WHEREAS, the Beaver County 2021 Hazard Mitigation Plan has been developed by the Beaver County Planning Commission Office and the Beaver County Emergency Services Department in cooperation with other county departments, local municipal officials, and the citizens of the Beaver County; and

WHEREAS, a public involvement process consistent with the requirements of DMA 2000 was conducted to develop the Beaver County 2021 Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Beaver County 2021 Hazard Mitigation Plan recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses to life and property affected by both natural

and human-made hazards that face the County and its municipal governments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Beaver, a fourth class county under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:

1. That, pursuant to the recommendation of Eric Brewer, Director of Beaver County Emergency Services, the Resolution approving the Beaver County 2021 Hazard Mitigation Plan, which identifies hazards, institutes community goals and selects mitigation opportunities appropriate for Beaver County, a copy of which is annexed hereto and by reference made a part hereof, is hereby approved.

2. That the Board of Commissioners, for and in behalf of the County of Beaver, is hereby authorized to execute said Plan and the Chief Clerk of the County of Beaver is hereby directed to attest the due execution thereof and to affix the Seal of the County of Beaver thereto.

3. That, following the proper execution, attestation and ensembling of said Plan, the Chief Clerk of the County of Beaver is hereby directed to cause delivery of the same to be made as follows: The original to the Controller of the County of Beaver.
